ORDER

THIS MATTER comes before the Court on Defendants' June 26, 2008 Motion to Dismiss Plaintiffs' request for injunctive relief. The injunctive relief sought in Plaintiffs' May 22, 2008 First Amended Complaint is:

Preliminary and permanent injunctive relief barring all further intimidation of plaintiffs Walter Chavez, Ana Galindo, and W.C., and any and all entry in the home of plaintiffs Walter Chavez, Ana Galindo, and W.C. absent a warrant issued by a judicial officer or informed, voluntary consent by either plaintiff Chavez or plaintiff Galindo.

ORDERED that pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(b)(1), Defendants' partial motion to dismiss is granted as it applies to a preliminary injunction without prejudice and

denied as it applies to a permanent injunction.
